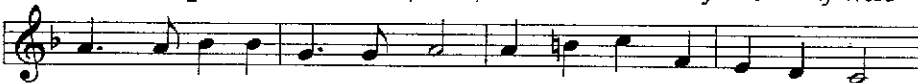

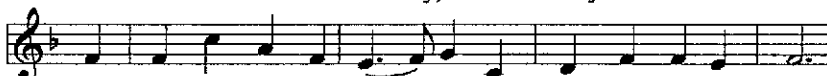

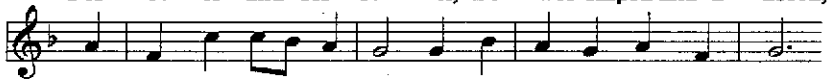

**SERMON****"FROM WATER TO WINE"****John 2:1-11**

- I. Jesus' first miracle, changing water to wine, doesn't seem a big deal, compared with healing leprosy or raising the dead.
- II. But John shows us that this miracle is a "sign" pointing us to Jesus' identity and mission.
