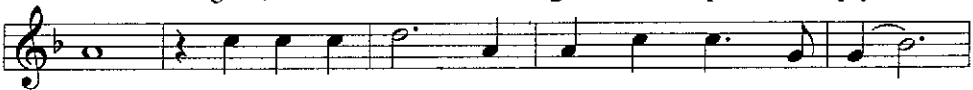

SERMON "NOW IS THE DAY OF SALVATION" 2 Corinthians 6:1-13

- I. Paul says that sin is a form of spiritual heart disease, where our hearts are closed off to God and to one another.
- II. Jesus has given us a spiritual heart transplant, creating new hearts in us.

NICENE CREED
